



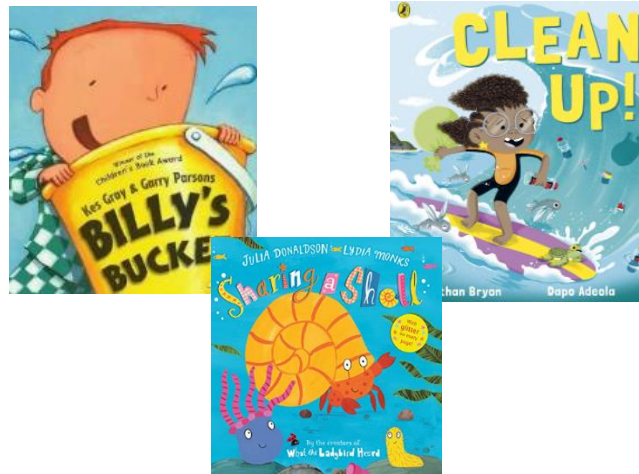
Sticky knowledge
